What Are Competency Evaluations?

Competency Evaluations offer a digital solution to tracking observations or evaluations of a clinician by an observer. These evaluations contain a list of points of care that measure the knowledge, skills, and abilities needed for a specific practice setting.

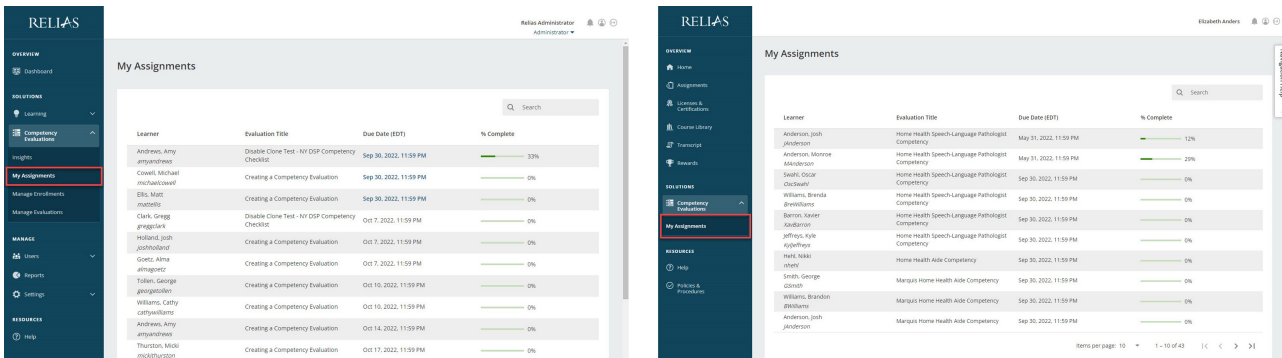
The Evaluation Interaction Role

The Evaluation Interaction role allows you to conduct Competency Evaluations. Conducting an evaluation includes rating Learners on individual competencies, notating the verification method you used, and attesting to the results.

Evaluations can be conducted from a PC, or at the point of care using a tablet. Competency Evaluations are optimized for mobile environments.

My Assignments

All your assigned evaluations will be listed under My Assignments. These assignments are created by those with the Evaluation Management and/or the Evaluation Enrollment roles.

The Search bar will help you find Learners by name or evaluation title. For example, if you want to see a list of assignments for the Home Health Speech-Language Pathologist Competency evaluation, you can search for “Speech-Language” as seen in the image below.

This will bring up the Index in which you can view the full evaluation. Expand levels and click on the second level to view competency statements. Competency statements that can be rated have drop-down menus for verification methods and rating. The Verification Method is how you verify the rating of a competency statement. Verification Methods include:

- Verbal Description

The Rating is how well the Learner performed the point of care.

Evaluations with Multiple Evaluators

Competency Evaluations can have multiple evaluators rating in the same evaluation assignment. There may be times in which one evaluator is qualified to rate a Learner on only a portion of the points of care covered in an evaluation. Thus, multiple evaluators can be used to rate one Learner within the same evaluation. Each evaluator will see the evaluation assigned under My Assignments and can access it just like any assignment.

Once an evaluator completes the attestation, other evaluators will not be able to modify any verification methods or ratings for the competency statements that were attested to. However, evaluators will be able to view the rating for any competency statement regardless of their attestation status.
